Discussion:

NPOL is operating nominally. It's been quite busy in fact scanning lots of rain over the last 24-36 hours. A variety of scanning has been accomplished with an emphasis on NPOL and D3R coordinated scanning over the disdrometer array in both stratiform and convection using both PPI sectors and RHI's, all the while maintaining better than 3 minute update rate on rain mapping. May 25th was a particularly good event for horizontal variability studies of stratiform precipitation with many hours of D3RNEAR30.

On Saturday May 25, 2013, 3 high quality bird bath scans were accomplished in stratiform echo with bright band: 25 May at about 1320, 1445 and 1730 UTC.
