Discussion:

NPOL and D3R attempted some coordinated vertically pointing scanning yesterday but the weather did not cooperate, with only very light precip at the NPOL site after the early morning hours. Regardless, NPOL and D3R performed several hours of coordinated RHI scanning over the disdrometer radial due to the passage of several light-to-moderate showers to our southeast. The evening and overnight hours were very quiet. Communications were lost overnight at XPOL-2 but other XPOLs are nominal. Communication problems are also currently plaguing portions of the disdrometer/gauge network.
