Status: Stand down for maintenance and/or crew rest as needed today through Friday, 7 PM.

We WILL have a forecast briefing Friday morning at 9 AM to get an update on the weekend forecast. NPOL (unstaffed) will maintain 10-minute surveillance/rain mapping through the stand down period. IFloodS domain is currently clear of precipitation. Forecast is for continued clearing of clouds and no chance of precipitation today/Thursday through Friday early evening.

Next chance of precipitation is sometime between 7 PM Friday and 1 AM Saturday local.

Memorial weekend looks to be potentially busy with chances of showers and thunderstorms each day (Sat-Mon). There is even a chance of some locally very heavy rain and training echoes later in the weekend, which could cause a notable hydrological response. Forecast for the weekend will be updated tomorrow at the briefing. The current plan is to have NPOL back up/staffed starting 7 PM Friday/tomorrow.
